Entries close at 9 am on Monday 11th January

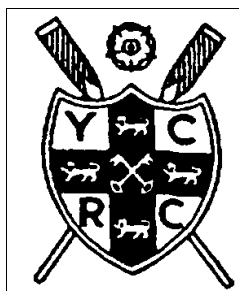
