No oarsman may row twice in the same event, but the same crew may row twice in different events. **Please make it clear in which division you wish to row**

Crews doubling up to use divisions one and three.
Crews competing once to row in division two where possible

The Masters handicap system may be used (See BR Almanac)

Please state clearly if **NOT** prepared to compete in higher status/age group

Events will be run at the organisers' discretion

All times will be combined and no account can be taken of any change in conditions
Entries close at 2.00 pm on Monday 14th November. Suspended earlier if safety limit reached
