Payment of fees is due by issue of the draw (expected COP Tuesday 14th June) after which fees are non-refundable. Any entries paid but not accepted into the draw will be refunded. If the event is cancelled in whole or in part, refunds will be considered minus any non-recoverable expenses.

Doubling is encouraged between divisions, but no doubling of competitors, boats or oars is allowed within a division

- **Senior** events will be split into bands against competitors of similar ranking index. The aim will be for no less than 4 and no more than 8 per band but racing against an appropriate ranking will take priority.
- **Masters** events will be handicapped where necessary. Masters without appropriate competition will be moved to Senior into a band with appropriate ranking index where timetabling allows.
- **Juniors** without opposition unable to be moved to a higher age group will be moved to Senior into a band with appropriate ranking index, in line with rules of racing, where timetabling allows.

Please state clearly if NOT prepared to compete in senior or handicapped events.
